
Essentials of IBM Rational RequisitePro V7.1

Overview:

This course provides instruction on the use of IBM Rational RequisitePro, a tool for capturing and managing requirements for a project. Students gain an understanding of RequisitePro project structure and use the tool to apply software development best practices. The computer labs guide students through building and adding data to a class project within the context of a controlled requirements management process. The labs completed in class focus on applying RequisitePro in a work environment.

- Define and customize RequisitePro project structure and components
 - Create and build a project
 - Create, import, and revise requirements, attributes, and requirement documents
 - Define hierarchies of requirements
 - Trace requirements to one another

 - Participate in group discussions
 - Create and compare RequisitePro baselines using the RequisitePro Baseline Manager

 - Establish a RequisitePro project
 - Gather and enter requirements
 - RequisitePro documents and offline authoring
 - Views, traceability, metrics, and RequisitePro Baseline Manager
 - Revision notification and group discussions
