<p>Module 3: Applicable laws and regulations</p> <p>Discusses the regulatory environment, common elements across jurisdictions and strategies for aligning compliance with organizational strategy.</p>	<p>Module 7: Training and awareness</p> <p>Outlines strategies for developing and implementing privacy training and awareness programs.</p>
