Overview:

Prerequisites:

APM Project Management (PMQ) Workshop 1 ~ 3 (APMPMQ1 ~ APMPMQ3)

Delegates are required to have relevant employment and that their employer will support the Delegates development with related work experience within which the PM learning may be applied and practiced.

Delegates are expected to have a minimum of grade C or above in at least 5 GCSEs including English and Mathematics. If not, this will be developed during the apprenticeship.

Testing and Certification

The APM Project Management Workshop Series leads to Level 4 APM Project Management Qualification (PMQ) exam.
